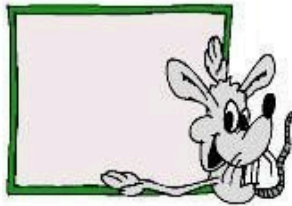
The story of a clever mouse
